

Hifuri-shinji: Marriage of the Gods 神々の結婚 火振り神事

The locals of Aso celebrate the marriage of the god Kunitatsu-no-Kami through whirling rings of fire. Bales of grass are attached to long ropes which are then lit on fire and swung wildly to cleanse the swinger of sin and dishonor. With sparks flying and flames swirling, it's as if these ancient rites are calling for the impatient Spring to come wake Aso from its Winter slumber.
