

### To All Foreign Residents Who Have a My Number Card



If you extend your period of stay, you are required to update the information on your My Number Card.

If you do not complete the extension process at the city hall service counter before the expiration date on your My Number Card, your card will become invalid. (It is a plastic IC card with a photo.)




If the expiration date of your period of stay is changed due to the renewal of your residence permit, this information will not be automatically reflected on your My Number Card. If you have a My Number Card, please go to the service counter to update this information.

If you change your address or name on your residence card, you must also update this information at the service counter within 14 days.

The service counter is at the Citizens' Affairs Division.

### **Throwing Away Garbage**



Garbage collection days vary depending on where you live. Please put your garbage out at the designated location by 8:30 a.m. on the designated day.

(If you are unsure of the designated location, please contact your district head, building manager, or real estate agency.)

### **How to Throw Away Garbage**



Please rinse out glass and plastic bottles.



Separate your garbage by its type. (Please refer to the sorting chart.)





Please put it in the designated trash bag. (Trash bags can be purchased at supermarkets, convenience stores, home centers, etc.)



Please put your garbage out at the designated place on the designated day. \*By 8:30 a.m.

### Magazines/Other Paper Recyclable Waste (Clothing/Cloth)




Tie magazines together, cardboard together, etc.



### Be sure to take your health insurance card (My Number Card or Certificate of Eligibility) with you to the hospital.



When you go to a hospital in Japan, you need an insurance card. If you do not bring your insurance card with you, the hospital will charge you a very high price.

### In case of illness, injury or fire

In case of an emergency (sudden illness or injury) or fire, call the fire department (#119).

When the call connects, please speak to the operator.

Ambulances are free, but please do not use them for minor illnesses or injuries.

Stop driving immediately. Move your vehicle to a safe place, such as the shoulder of the road or an empty lot, so as not to obstruct other traffic.

Call the police (#110) and tell the responding police officer what happened. \*If someone is injured, call an ambulance (#119).





Even if you think you are not injured or only slightly injured, you may realize later that you have a serious injury, so please go to the hospital as soon as possible.





You may need a Traffic Accident Certificate to receive support after a traffic accident. Please proceed with the inquiry application process at the police station where you reported the accident.

### **Potential Disasters in Aso City**



The ground shakes. If it is a large earthquake, buildings may collapse or fires may occur.



### **Heavy Rain**

A"localized torrential downpour" is rain that falls very intensely over a short period, increases the risk of landslides -> It may increase the risk of landslides

### **Typhoons**

Involve heavy rain and very strong winds. Often hit Japan from summer to autumn.



### **Volcanic Eruptions**

A phenomenon where magma and volcanic ash erupt into the air. Possibility of falling volcanic ash and rocks.
